<p>Excuses excuses J. Potts ETP July 2004</p>	<p>Brainstorm a list of household chores. S/s take turns to choose a chore. <i>I was going to do the ironing but my mother rang. I was going to do the ironing but there was a power failure.</i></p>
<p>It didn't happen J. Potts</p>	<p>Make a 6x6 grid and write prompts in each square. E.g. Cristina / look for new job/last year. Throw a dice make sentence for corresponding square. <i>Wasn't Cristina going to look for a new job last year?</i></p>
<p>Famous lives</p>	<p>Choose 10-12 famous people (Google: biographies.com) Note key events. S/S get 3 cards and create sentences eg. <i>Audrey Hepburn was going to be a ballet dancer but she grew too tall.</i></p>
<p>Chain story J. Potts</p>	<p>Form groups with s/s and give them 2 starting sentences. <i>Last Sunday I was going to get up early but.....</i>Next student <i>I was going to go out for a run but...</i></p>
<p>Eyewitness Hadfield Advanced Communication Games 23. (8-15 students)</p>	<p>Past and Past Perfect/ sequence connectives. The object of this game is to find out where Jenny is being held by the kidnappers! Cards for S/s eg. You are the librarian. Jenny came in early yesterday afternoon. Game also has a map to draw her movements in town. <i>She was going to pop into the shop</i></p>
