Have you recently fallen on hard times and find it (financially) difficult to attend ETAS events?

Would you like to join ETAS but don't have sufficient income to pay your membership?

Would you like to renew your membership but simply can't afford it?

Would you like to come to an event by public transport as per the ETAS sustainability position, and you can't afford it?

If you answer one (or more) of the questions above with 'yes', and live in Switzerland, then the Hardship Fund is for you.

Here's how it works:

Apply for support by filling in the application form.

Application form sections

2) The assistance you are seeking and why

Please submit your application to office@e-tas.ch. We will confirm receipt of your application and then process it. We may ask you for further information.

Once we have everything we will let you know our decision as soon as possible.

Our decision will be based on your application and the financial means ETAS has for the hardship fund. ETAS reserves the right to adapt or limit the conditions of the Hardship Fund.

The financial support will either go directly to the event you are seeking assistance for or to ETAS membership fees. If you are applying for assistance for public transport, you will receive a voucher.
